

Instructions for On-line Note Reading Assignments (Mrs. Warby's classes)

1. Go to the website: www.musictheory.net
2. Click the "exercises" icon on the left.
3. Chose note identification (the top one).
4. Scroll down and click "yes" under "Would you like to customize your exercise?"
5. Click the treble, and/or bass, and/or alto, and/or tenor clef boxes, depending on the assignment given in class.
6. Under "In what range should notes appear?" click the third box (the middle one).
7. Only the key signature for C should be checked. (No sharps or flats)
8. Under "Should accidentals be used?" check "no."
9. Complete the required number of questions as given in class.
10. When you are finished, click the "cog" icon in the top right corner located between the timer and tiny keyboard and a dialog box will appear below it.
11. Click on the "Show Progress Report" button near the bottom of the dialog box.
12. Then click on "Print Report" located on the bottom left of the report.
13. Turn in that report to the inbox in Mrs. Warby's room by the due date given.

Due Dates:

- 50 drills on the Treble Clef—The report is due August 26, 2011
- 50 drills on the Bass Clef—The report is due September 1, 2011
- 50 drills in Treble & Bass Clefs **with a score of 100%** is due September 9, 2011
