

# 2019 Choir Tour Rules Contract

## Hotel Expectations

- **Boys and girls may not under any circumstances be in each other's hotel rooms at any time. Meet in the lobby or public areas of the hotel if you wish to hang out with the opposite sex.**
- Always be in groups of 3 or more people.
- Keep your chaperone informed at all times as to where you are.
- Be quiet and courteous to other hotel guests.
- **Nightly curfew: Be in own room by 10:00 p.m. or 1/2 hour after returning to the hotel each night. Students who break this rule will be sent home at their parents' expense.**
- Phones should not be used from your hotel room. Use cell phones if you must call long distance. Avoid calling other rooms after curfew unless it is an emergency and you are calling your chaperone.
- Keep your hotel rooms clean. If you break anything you pay for it!

## Travel Expectations

- Do not board the coach if you are seriously ill with something like the stomach flu. We cannot have your germs spread to the other members of the group. Stay home!
- Be on time! Coaches will leave at the time on the itinerary or as announced. Be at the coaches 10 minutes early. If you are more than 5 minutes late, you may be left behind. This especially applies to leaving AFHS!
- Only one medium size bag (50 lbs. or less) and one carry on (+ blanket/pillow) is permitted on the trip.
- Because of many tastes and standards, we generally will not watch DVDs on the TVs in the coaches. If we do watch DVDs, it is at the discretion of your bus captains. If you wish to watch a movie, bring your own DVD player or computer with headphones.
- No switching coaches. This makes it too hard to keep track of everyone.

## Rules of General Conduct

- Remember that you are representing American Fork High School . . . Show a lot of class.
- Act with propriety when in concert, shows, festivals, clinics, etc. Do not embarrass the group or yourself with inappropriate or immature behavior. **Keep your pants on!**
- You are expected to participate in all scheduled activities. You can only leave the tour with a parent. Other family members may meet you at the sightseeing activities or concerts on the tour, but it is district policy that you cannot leave the tour unless it is with your parent.
- **DO NOT KNOWINGLY EAT FOOD TO WHICH YOU HAVE EVEN THE SMALLEST OF ALLERGIC REACTIONS.**
- **All school rules apply while on tour. This includes dress standards!!! Indecent exposure (mooning), lewd or offensive language or behavior, strip poker of any kind, or public displays of affection will not be tolerated. No boxing gloves or other items (including "fart spray") that are not acceptable to use during school hours are allowed. No smoking, alcohol, or drugs (other than those listed on your health form) are permitted. This includes the taking of caffeine tablets to stay awake all night. Criminal offenses, such as shoplifting, will be grounds to send you home at your own expense.** Bring your AFHS handbook if you have any questions. What is not acceptable at school is not acceptable on tour.
- You are responsible to carry your own luggage. Luggage is limited to one medium-sized suitcase that weighs 50 lbs. or less, and one carry-on or backpack.
